
Counsel for the Public filed today the pre-filed direct testimony of retained expert witnesses in the areas of overhead transmission line review and the assessment of potential effects to aboveground historical sites and cultural landscapes from the proposed Northern Pass Transmission Line (the “Project”).

Counsel for the public requested, and the Committee approved by Order dated May 25, 2016, the retention of Siemens Industry, Inc. (“Siemens”) as one of the consultants regarding transmission line design and construction. Siemens has reviewed documents and attended technical sessions related to the design of the overhead sections of the Project. This letter is to inform the Committee and the parties in this matter that Counsel for the Public will not be filing pre-filed direct testimony by Siemens, but will be filing at a later date a report by Siemens on their review of the design of the Project’s overhead sections.
