**March 8-Counsel for the Public- Michael Buscher, James Palmer, and Jeremy Owens – T.J. Boyle Associates**


1. Provide all handwritten notes maintained by TJ Boyle.
2. Provide a list of the work product that was relied upon from the draft DEIS used in the evaluation submitted in the SEC docket.
3. Provide the number of locations that were actually visited for the field investigations.
4. Provide a list of parcels in current use and where these exist in the data files, if any.
5. Provide examples of other work that TJ Boyle conducted where parking lots and/or strip malls were evaluated as a scenic resource.
6. Provide written guidelines, if any exist that contain instructions for filling out the forms at the community workshops.
7. Provide the script that was used, if any, at the community resource meetings.
8. Provide a list of survey research conducted by Dr. Palmer, in the context of a visual resource assessment, where the public was asked to identify scenic resources of importance.
9. Provide the example that was used for the low end of the visual spectrum at the community meetings (Mt. Washington was used as the high end).

10. Identify which of the 41 scenic resources overlap with the 446 resources identified by TJ Boyle.
11. Provide any post-construction transmission line aesthetic mitigation evaluations that were conducted by TJ Boyle or others.

The foregoing shall be provided to all of the parties on or before March 20, 2017. Copies shall not be provided to the Committee. To the extent that the Counsel for the Public objects to providing the above referenced material, the requesting party must file a Motion to Compel with the Committee.
