Dear Ms. Miller:

This letter follows the status report you provided on March 7, 2017 to the Site Evaluation Committee. As we discussed at our Quarterly Meeting on March 9, 2017, we are submitting this letter to you in the context of the SEC proceeding to provide additional detail on the status of the our assessment of historic sites and the schedule for completion of the remaining work. We appreciate your review of our summary below, and invite your comment on it.

I offer below a summary of the work that has been performed under the December 4, 2015 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between DHR and Northern Pass, and the expected schedule for completing that work and the effects assessment to follow.

- We have provided monthly reports and met quarterly with DHR as required under § D.2 of the MOU. The monthly report for March 2017 is enclosed.
- Eversource created the new position of cultural resource specialist for its New Hampshire operations, and I was hired to fill that position in June 2016. (§ D.1) As you know, I have worked directly with the DHR on a continuous basis since that date to advance the work being performed under the MOU.
- With the exception of the Phase IB survey work along four miles of the underground route in the north section of the Project, all Phase I archaeological survey work has been completed. (§ B.4-5) In addition, beyond the MOU requirements, we have commenced Phase II archeological evaluation. There are twenty-two potentially eligible sites, four of which are being avoided. Of the remaining eighteen (18) potentially eligible archaeological sites requiring Phase II, eight have been evaluated. The remaining Phase II archaeological evaluation work is scheduled to begin as soon as field conditions allow this spring, with the Phase II fieldwork to be completed by early summer.
- As suggested in your March 7, 2017 status report but to clarify, all one hundred eight (108) of the required survey forms for above ground historic resources have

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been completed and submitted to the DHR. (§ C.6) We appreciate your efforts in expeditiously reviewing them.

- Additionally, we have made substantial efforts to complete the cultural landscape studies identified in the MOU (§ C.5) and further described in the scope of work provided by DHR in late September and reviewed with the U.S. Department of Energy on October 4, 2016. Public Archaeology Laboratory, Inc. (“PAL”) has been retained to perform these studies. The February 1, 2017 deadline referenced in the DHR letter to the SEC was a target DHR set in the scope of work. However, as you know, the reason we did not meet that target is because the DOE Consulting Party process was delayed by factors out of our control. Please see the attached monthly report for additional details.

As set forth above, most of the resource identification and evaluation work required by the MOU has been completed. We continue to work with you in your review of the aboveground resources survey forms, and the only remaining archaeological resources identification work outstanding is the small section of the underground route in the north section of the Project. We greatly appreciate your ongoing review of these reports and forms.

We look forward to our continued close work with the DHR and other consulting parties in the Section 106 process to conclude the remaining work described above and the negotiation of an appropriate Programmatic Agreement to ensure protection of these important resources during construction of the project.

## Northern Pass Transmission – Monthly Report

March 13, 2017

This is our March NPT monthly report, as required by the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) from December 2015. Overall, we are pleased that, as you have seen in prior reports and as summarized below, we have been able to complete nearly all of the cultural resources identification work and a majority of the cultural resources evaluation work associated with the project. We are also pleased that the effects assessment phase for aboveground resources is underway. We are confident that the Northern Pass team will be able to complete the cultural resources assessment work, including reporting, this summer. We know that it has meant substantial additional work on the DHR's part to review and comment on the ongoing work, and we are grateful for your efforts.

### Archaeology

Phase IB survey and reporting for the overhead portion of the project area is complete. All the associated reports have been submitted to the DHR and the DHR has subsequently concurred with the management recommendations presented in all the Phase IB reports. As such, the identification phase is complete with regard to archaeological resources within the overhead portion of the route.

For the underground portion of the route, Phase IB survey work has been completed, with the exception of an approximately four mile portion along locally maintained roads in Stewartstown and Clarksville. The survey results for the underground portion have been presented in a single report and submitted to the DHR on February 17, 2017.

A total of twenty-two potentially eligible archaeological sites (twelve pre-contact; ten post-contact) have been identified within the direct APE as part of the Phase IB survey effort. Phase II testing is planned for all twelve of the potentially eligible pre-contact sites along the route. Phase II testing is planned for six of the ten potentially eligible post-contact sites, as four of the ten potentially eligible post-contact sites will be avoided by the project.

Phase II evaluation of these eighteen potentially eligible archeological sites is partially complete. Thus far, Phase II evaluation has been completed at five pre-contact sites and three post-contact sites. The remaining ten Phase II site evaluations will be conducted as early as possible this spring. A report summarizing the Phase II evaluation results from this past fall will be submitted to the DHR this winter or early spring and a report summarizing this spring's Phase II evaluation results will be submitted to the DHR as soon as possible after the conclusion of the field work. Additionally, the DHR will be notified in advance of Phase II excavation at each of the remaining sites, including the Appleton Street Site (27MR0396).

We will discuss with DHR any possible Phase III data recovery recommendations immediately upon confirmation that any Phase III work is needed. To date, NPT's consultant has not recommended Phase III data recovery for any of the completed Phase II evaluation sites.

## Historical above-ground resources

We have now completed all inventory forms as required by the DHR pursuant to DHR review of the Project Area Forms as presented in the “green sheets”. To date, one hundred and eight inventory forms have been submitted to the DHR. An additional twenty-nine resources were eliminated from consideration in consultation with the DHR for one of the following reasons: resource falls outside project APE or ZVI; resource lacks integrity or setting; individual property captured as part of an historic district; resource found not eligible as a historic district and individual properties inventoried instead; or resource listing duplicated on two or more green sheets. These counts exclude the reports to be generated as a result of the cultural landscape studies discussed in the following two paragraphs. We have begun to complete DHR effects tables for each resource having the potential to be affected by the project.

The assessment of cultural landscapes as identified in the December 2015 MOU has progressed well in the last few months. In late September 2016 we received a draft scope of work developed by the DHR pertaining to the inventory of cultural landscapes for the NPT Project. We participated in a call with the DHR and the US Department of Energy (DOE) to discuss the scope of work on October 4, 2016. We subsequently selected The Public Archaeology Laboratory, Inc. (PAL) to carry out the cultural landscape studies. On October 20, 2016 we participated in a meeting with DHR and PAL to discuss the cultural landscape studies and ensure we understood the DHR’s expectations. Eversource and PAL joined the DOE and the DHR in a call on November 1, 2016 among the consulting parties to discuss the scope of work developed by the DHR for the cultural landscapes studies and to explain the consulting party input process. In person consulting party meetings were scheduled for December 14, 2016 in Concord and December 15, 2016 in Whitefield to present the initial findings of the cultural landscape studies to, and request additional input from, the consulting parties. The DOE postponed those meetings. The meetings were rescheduled by the DOE and held on January 23, 2017 in Concord and January 26, 2017 in Whitefield, as part of DOE’s continuing efforts to engage consulting parties.

Cultural landscape questionnaires were posted to the DOE’s consulting party website prior to the meetings in January 2017 for the two study areas prescribed in the DHR scope of work. A generic questionnaire was also posted to cover areas adjacent to the project route within the Great North Woods and other areas not included in the Pemigewasset and Suncook river valleys study areas. The DOE specified that the consulting party responses were to be submitted via email to Mark Doperalski at Eversource, copying Caitlin Callahan at the DOE, Nadine Miller at the DHR and Ginny Adams at PAL. Public versions of the questionnaires were also posted to the DOE’s public website. The DOE closed the period to provide input on cultural landscapes on February 28, 2017. Two additional consulting party calls were held by the DOE to follow-up on information provided by the consulting parties through February 17, 2017 regarding the Pemigewasset and Suncook river valley study areas (February 28, 2017) and areas in the Great North Woods and other areas beyond the two previously prescribed study areas (March 2, 2017). Results of the cultural landscape studies will be presented in a series of volumes. The volumes will describe the overall cultural landscape study and the cultural landscapes identified and evaluated for each study area. Based on the input provided by consulting parties and the public, the project team proposes to submit documentation associated with the Suncook River Valley study area at the end of March 2017; documentation

associated with the Pemigewasset River Valley study area in mid-May 2017; and documentation associated with the Great North Woods, Deerfield, and Ammonoosuc River Valley study areas at the end of June 2017. These submittal dates are subject to change per additional stipulations that may be imposed by the DHR and/or DOE.

### **Coordination with DOE**

NPT received comments from the DOE and USFS in October 2016 on the Work Plan that we prepared in consultation with DHR and submitted to DOE in July 2016. Revisions were made to the document to address those comments and the revised Work Plan was submitted to the DOE on December 16, 2016. Work is ongoing on the Historic Properties Treatment Plan (HPTP) and the PA Quarterly Reporting Document Template per the request of the DOE. The DOE stated that these documents will be appended to the Programmatic Agreement (PA) and that NPT's assistance in drafting these documents will help move development of the PA along. The DOE has indicated that the PA will likely be issued in July 2017.
