

Re: New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee ("SEC") Docket No. 2015-06 Northern Pass
Petition to Intervene

Dear Ms. Monroe:

We, Torin and Brian Judd, respectfully request to intervene in the SEC's proceedings under Docket No. 2015-06 relating to the proposed Northern Pass transmission line. Per the SEC's regulations, we are sending this request to you.

Our particular rights, duties, privileges, immunities and other substantial interests will be affected by this proceeding in numerous ways, including but not limited to, the following:

We live at 96-A Mount Delight Road in Deerfield on 48 acres of wooded land. We have thoughtfully put much cultivation into our property including select cutting tree species in overabundance, planting many more trees, and making an access road throughout the property to maintain. The property is posted land and is a haven for animal species including deer, moose, black bear, fisher, bobcat, and many species of birds. We have placed our dwelling in such a spot as to enjoy a view to the southeast of Mt. Pawtuckaway. It so happens that that this view faces where Northern Pass transmission line has been proposed; on the longest side of our property line which abuts the existing power lines. We cannot see the existing power lines now as the tops are just below the tree line. The proposed towers would far exceed the height of the existing towers, creating an eyesore in front of what is now a beautiful and peaceful view.

Wildlife habitat is also our concern. Whether the lines are buried or standing we are concerned about the effects of such a tremendous amount of voltage passing right through the animal paths and so close to our home.

In addition, we have some very valued old trees along that property line; Black Tupelo trees which, according to a professional forester are more than 300 years old. We hate to think of losing them if they were deemed a threat to the lines based upon their height and position relative to the towers.

Lastly we are concerned about the power line affecting the value of our property. We have worked hard to make this a haven, maintaining it's natural beauty and balance. We respectfully request that the power lines not be placed through Deerfield.

No other entities could articulate our specific interests and concerns in the proceedings for this docket as well as we could.

Allowing this intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings, and would help to serve the interests of justice.

We respectfully request that the SEC grant its Petition for Intervention and granting such other and further relief as it deems appropriate. I have served copies of this petition to the legally pertinent parties electronically.
