Motion to Intervene

We, Paul and Dana O’Hara, 68 Church St. Franconia, NH respectfully request to intervene in the captioned docket.

Memorandum in Support of Motion

We own a property in fee located along Route 116, Franconia, Grafton County, New Hampshire. A right of way easement was acquired from our predecessors in title on the property for the purpose of a road way.

NPT and PSNH do not have a right to a Certificate of Site and Facility in, under or about the road way easement described above because the easement did not grant such rights to PSNH or NPT to be used for private electric transmission infrastructure. Such rights are ours.

Our property is located only 25 feet from Route 116. Our home is 125 years old and we fear that any digging could damage the foundation. Also, we are concerned with the high voltage wire running so close to our home. We see no reason to run this through a residential community.

We, therefore, request that we be granted the right to intervene in this docket.
