Dear Ms. Monroe:

We respectfully request to intervene in the SEC's proceedings under Docket NO. 2015-06 relating to the proposed Northern Pass transmission line. Per the SEC's regulations, we are sending this request to you, with copies to the SEC's distribution list for this proceeding as noted in the "cc" below.

Our particular rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other substantial interests that may be affected by the SEC's Northern Pass proceedings include the following:

Eversource currently owns two sets of transmission lines and towers, collectively that transverse the road on which we reside. These two sets of lines also transverse our property. The proposed Northern Pass power line requested in this docket would also transverse our property. Several of the existing transmission towers are visible from our property. Several of the proposed new towers would also be visible from our property. In addition, we drive and walk under the existing transmission lines regularly and would have to have to cross under the proposed new transmission lines as well.

The aesthetics of our neighborhood, value of our home and the public health would be greatly decreased with this project.

- Although the construction of the new transmission line will occur in an existing right of way, a significant number of trees will have to be removed.
- The number of trees that this project proposes to remove will grossly affect the aesthetics, the public health, and a large area of the environment.
- Trees naturally remove carbon in the environment. The removal of such a large volume of trees will increase the carbon footprint for the area.
- Trees also help to weaken the strength of the electromagnetic fields. The added electromagnetic field that would accompany the proposed new transmission line along with such a large volume of trees removed from the area would cause damage to the public health.
- The addition of a third high voltage transmission line would increase the exposure to the health risks associated with such high voltage transmission lines.
