Based on available information, including statements made by realtors and even the author of a study cited by Northern Pass that were reported by local media (such as the New Hampshire Union Leader and New Hampshire Public Radio), I believe the potential visual impact of the proposed transmission line will adversely affect the value of the property I own in Bethlehem.
