## UNCONTESTED MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE

The Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests (the "Forest Society"), by and through its attorneys, BCM Environmental & Land Law, PLLC, requests a deadline extension as follows:

- On February 26, 2016 the Joint Applicant filed Applicants' Response and
   Objection to Certain Petitions to Intervene ("Intervention Response"); and Applicants' Request
   for Partial Waivers Under the Newly Adopted SEC Rules ("Waiver Request").
- 2. Objections to these would be due on Monday March 7, 2016 pursuant to Site 202.14(f).
- 3. The Forest Society respectfully requests an extension of that deadline until Friday March 11, 2016.
- 4. Pursuant to Site 202.14(d), undersigned counsel has contacted counsel for the Joint Applicant who does not object to the extension requested, but does not concede that the Forest Society has the right to file any response. Undersigned counsel has also contacted Counsel for Public, who consents to the extension requested.

WHEREFORE, the Forest Society respectfully requests that the deadline for the Forest Society to respond to the Joint Applicants' Intervention Response and Waiver Request be extended from March 7, 2011 to March 11, 2016.
