**Partially Assented-to Motion by New England Power Generators
Association, Inc. for an Extension of Time in which to Propound
Data Requests**

NOW COMES The New England Power Generators Association (NEPGA) and respectfully requests that the Site Evaluation Committee (SEC) extend NEPGA's July 8, 2016 deadline to propound data requests to July 25, 2016. In support of this motion, NEPGA states as follows:

1. In its Order on Pending Motions and Procedural Order dated June 23, 2016 ("Procedural Order") the SEC expressly recognized NEPGA's right to review an unredacted version, subject to the execution of a confidentiality agreement, of the economic analysis and further required that NEPGA issue data requests relating to this information by July 8, 2016.
2. Despite good faith efforts by counsel for NEPGA and counsel for NPT aimed at reaching an agreement regarding confidentiality, the parties did not reach an agreement until July 8, 2016.

3. In light of the fact that NEPGA has not yet had the opportunity to review the confidential information referred to in the SEC's Procedural Order, NPT and NEPGA have also agreed to extend the time period for NEPGA to propound its second round of data requests on economic issues until July 25, 2016.

4. The following parties concur in this Motion: Northern Pass Transmission, LLC, Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests, Bridgewater, New Hampton, Woodstock, Littleton, Deerfield, Ashland Water and Sewer, Stewartstown Clarksville non-abutters group, Bethlehem, Bristol, Easton, Franconia, Northumberland, Plymouth, Sugar Hill and Whitefield, Dummer, Stark and Northumberland abutting property intervenors, Conservation Law Foundation, and City of Concord.

The following parties take no position: Berlin and Franklin.

WHEREFORE, NEPGA respectfully requests that the SEC:

A. Extend the deadline for NEPGA to propound data requests on economic issues until July 25, 2016; and


B. Grant such further relief as it deems appropriate.


