# COUNSEL FOR THE PUBLIC'S OBJECTION TO APPLICANTS' PARTIALLY ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO HAVE TECHNICAL SESSIONS TRANSCRIBED

Counsel for the Public, by his attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General and Primmer Piper Eggleston & Cramer PC, hereby objects to the Applicants' Partially Assented-to Motion to Have Technical Sessions Transcribed (the "Motion") and in support states as follows.

1. Under Site 202.12 (Discovery), technical sessions are one form of discovery. Under SEC past practice, "[t]he purpose of technical sessions is for the parties and their experts to understand the testimony of the witnesses and engage in a dialogue about the testimony. A technical session is not designed to provide an opportunity for cross-examination, nor is it designed to allow parties to set up methods of impeachment." <u>Application of Antrim Wind</u> <u>Energy, LLC</u>, Docket No. 2015-02 (July 7, 2016).

2. The SEC's rules provide for both depositions and technical sessions. "Depositions, in civil judicial proceedings, are formal statements generally under oath and transcribed. Technical sessions are a more informal method for understanding information that has already been provided in the form of pre-filed testimony." <u>Id</u>.

3. The Motion does not set forth any reason why the technical sessions in this proceeding need to be transcribed.

4. Counsel for the Public believes that recording and transcribing the technical sessions will transform them into more formal proceedings than they are designed to be, which will impede and possibly deter the dialogue necessary to fully understand the pre-filed testimony.

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5. Counsel for the Public also is concerned that recording and transcribing the technical sessions will lead to more disputes or could otherwise lengthen the time necessary to complete the technical sessions.

6. Finally, Counsel for the Public is concerned that recording and transcribing the technical sessions will work to the disadvantage of the many unrepresented parties in this case. Deposition practice, which is what the technical sessions are bound to become if transcribed, is a lawyer's art. Many of the parties do not have lawyers and will not enjoy the full benefits of the technical sessions under a legalistic deposition environment.

WHEREFORE, Counsel for the Public respectfully requests that the SEC:

- Deny Applicants' Partially Assented-to Motion to Have Technical Sessions Recorded; and
- B. Grant such other and further relief as is just and equitable.
