NOW COMES the Grafton County Commissioners, by and through the Office of  
the Grafton County Attorney, Lara Joan Saffo, County Attorney and states as follows:

1. The Grafton County Commissioners filed a Motion outlining Further Response to Motions Regarding Scheduling and Motion to Continue Adjudicatory Hearing on Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
2. The Grafton County Commissioners filed it on an expedited basis because motions were pending regarding scheduling. However, the commissioners noted on its pleadings that, after giving parties the opportunity to respond, it would update the Site Evaluation Committee on concurrences.
3. The following intervenors concurred:
