## Re: Joint Application of Northern Pass Transmission, LLC and Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy for a Certificate of Site and Facility

On October 19, 2015, Northern Pass Transmission, LLC and Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (collectively Applicant), filed an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility (Application) with the Site Evaluation Committee (Committee). The Applicant seeks the issuance of a Certificate of Site and Facility approving the siting, construction, and operation of a 192-mile transmission line and associated facilities with a capacity rating of up to 1,090 MW from the Canadian border in Pittsburg in Coos County to Deerfield in Rockingham County (Project).

On December 18, 2015, the duly appointed Subcommittee considering the Application issued an order finding that the Application contained sufficient information to carry out the purposes of RSA 162-H.

RSA 162-H:10, I-c, requires that within 90 days after acceptance of an application for a certificate, that the Site Evaluation Committee shall hold at least one public hearing in each county where the proposed facility will be located. The public hearing is a joint hearing, with representatives of state agencies that have permitting or other regulatory authority over the subject matter and shall be in lieu of all hearings otherwise required by any of the other state agencies. The public hearing will also provide the public with information on the proposed project and an opportunity for the public to submit oral and written comments and to ask questions.

For the convenience of the public, this hearing will be conducted in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Energy to receive comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DOE/EIS-0463) and the Supplement to the Draft EIS (DOE/EIS-0463-S1).

The Coos County public hearing will be held on March 7, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. at the Colebrook Elementary School, 27 Dumont Street, Colebrook, NH.

The Merrimack County public hearing will be held on March 10, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. at the Grappone Center, 70 Constitution Avenue, Concord, NH.
