Hello everyone below is some important news about the NH Site- environmental impact process and the dates

Before going into this this. I want to make the following corrections to what I said yesterday. I was not technically correct on some things I said and want to make sure you get the information correctly. So From Rep Larry Rappaport's the correct info . Details are important so I thank him for taking the time to let me know so I can let you know correctly:

A few corrections: HB 302 was killed (voted inexpedient to legislate) by our committee not tabled. This is a recommendation to the House of Representatives. The bill will still be voted on the floor of the House of Representatives. The details about how a bill works is important for all of us to know .

Representatives. If the bill is killed there, that's the end of it. If it somehow passes, it still needs to be passed by the Senate and signed by the Governor. We did not table the bill. It will not come back for discussion before the committee.

Ray Burton is not a councilman, he is an Executive Councilor. More important, perhaps, he has over 30 years of experience in NH government and the correct title was Councilman - it is Executive Councilor people listen to him. I did know this but thought

According to Senator Gallus, with whom I spoke, SB 118 will be modified substantially. It is supposed to support the Laidlaw project. I was not allowed to remove my name from it. Long story - the short version is that I knew the correct details , he did not want to support. Explanation on how Rep Rappaport ended up looking like he was cosponsor on a bill that when he never wanted my name on it. Perhaps now that it is being changed, I will be allowed to remove my name.

Please spread the word quickly. These are very important meetings which are part of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) pursuant to National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to assess the environmental impacts from the proposed action of granting a Presidential Permit to Northern Pass Transmission.
