The only activity in State government at this time for the Northern Pass is legislative. The NH Site Evaluation Committee (<http://www.nhsec.nh.gov>) has not yet received a formal application from project proponents and doesn't expect one until the federal reviews are completed, likely sometime next year. However, legislative hearings are ongoing. For example, this week they have been discussing the proper use of eminent domain as it relates to the project, among other issues. 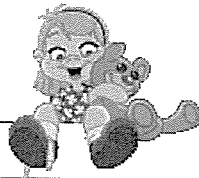
