Eversource has continually ignored the wants of the citizens of New Hampshire. The people have spoken, and the majorities view is that the entire line needs to be buried or the project cannot go forward. I am not a super environmentalist leftist, and understand the importance and need of new energy sources, but this projects effects on our state outweigh its benefits.

Only ten percent of this projects power distribution has been allotted for use in NH, while the entire 186 miles of line run through it! This is crazy! Not only that, but Eversource has not guaranteed that New Hampshire's electric rates will decrease.
