To the SEC:

I am the state representative for Grafton County District 2, which includes Franconia, Sugar Hill, Lisbon, Lyman, and Monroe. I am also director of the Ammonoosuc Conservation Trust, which is an intervenor in the DOE process re Northern Pass, and has applied for intervenor status with the SEC.

I am writing on behalf of numerous constituents who have contacted me, the towns I represent, and my organization. It is only fair and reasonable that you postpone your public hearings until after the March 15 deadline for Northern Pass to file its supplemental information.

It is vitally important that the process regarding Northern Pass is fair and transparent. At a time when general public trust in government at every level is at an all-time low, it would be most unfortunate if these hearing proceed as planned and give the appearance of an unfair and unresponsive process. Allowing the public time to review and respond to the latest Northern Pass information simply makes sense.
