As a resident of Randolph, NH I would like to express my opposition to Northern Pass as proposed. As you are aware, Eversource and Hydro-Quebec have put forward several different proposals as opposition has mounted and become more vocal.

I feel the line should be buried as they are being buried in Vermont and Maine. Though Northern Pass proponents say it would be uneconomical to bury the lines, they have not stated they would lose money on the project. I am also concerned that with the project as proposed, NH gets to deal with the scenic costs and gets none of the benefits of the electricity.

As part of the agreement Northern Pass should bury the line, pay to upgrade the electric grid so new renewable energy projects can come on line and contribute to our electrical generation.

Northern NH should not be the sacrificial lamb for Massachusetts.
