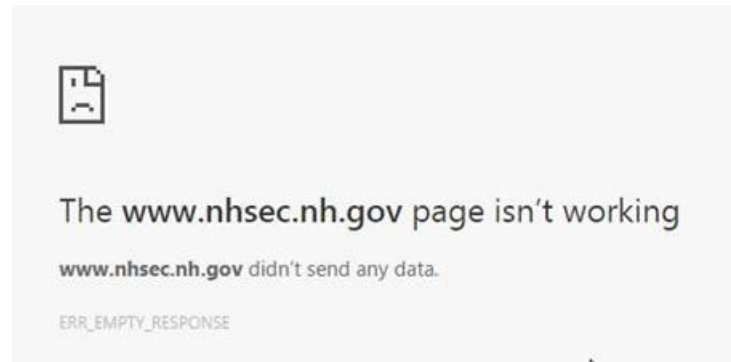

No order on intervenor groupings.

No transcript of the Loon meeting.

No reliable access to documents, no apology to those of us who wasted our time waiting for documents to download, no apology from the SEC for the inadequacy of the site.



Mr. Honigberg tells unpaid intervenors we just have to work harder, while the well-paid SEC is unable to read even part of the documents required to stay current with the docket.

The applicant misleads the SEC repeatedly during questioning while intervenors who could answer the SEC's questions are cowed into silence by Mr. Honigberg's rudeness.

The applicant did not gather their data in six months as Mr. Needleman "thought." They announced their project in Easton in 2010, and had been working on the plan before then. It took NPT more than five years to get their third unwilling "bride" to the altar. Mssrs. Needleman, Getz, Bellis and Bisbee appear to fear they will be left there if the intervenors' expert witnesses have time for a thorough assessment of this prospect.
