My sister Katherine Landrigan and I along with our spouses are the 5th generation landowners of property on Nottingham Road abutting the historic town cemetery off of the Deerfield Parade. Please see attached tax map. This property has been passed down through generations with the intent of preserving open space for recreation and farmland. Our goals for the property are to maintain that tradition and keep the land open and active for agricultural and recreational activity. However, we also appreciate the property's development potential. Subdividing into a limited number of low density house lots that take advantage of the sites rural appeal, open farm-land setting and views would achieve it's highest development potential. We would be robbed of this potential if the Northern Pass is approved and is why we are wholly and vehemently opposed to the construction of the Northern Pass. Building the proposed out of place and obtrusive towers will permanently destroy the rural character of Deerfield. The views to the south of Pawtuckaway State Park from the height of land on Nottingham Road will be forever marred by the Northern Pass project. Construction of the towers will impede our views and will significantly diminish not only market value of our property, which my family has worked diligently to maintain and preserve for over 150 years, but also diminish the rural appeal and charm this area offers.
