Whether one agrees with the concept of the Northern Pass project or not, I believe there are issues of propriety that should be considered.

For instance, how is it appropriate for NP to appeal the AG's decision about the Tillotson Foundation decision to sell a certain parcel to SPNF instead of NP?

More recently NP's requests to have access to all the information SPNF has about who is opposing this enterprise seems entirely out-of-line. Thankfully, the courts agreed. Although they have joined forces with Eversource, this is essentially a foreign corporation. Why should the state of NH be required to defend it's decisions to them? The issue of whether a foreign, for-profit company should have eminent domain privilege here is highly questionable as well, to say the least. Yet it seems to keep asserting itself in spite of laws to the contrary.
