Subject: Stop Northern Pass

Please add my name to the list of people who do not wish to see the Northern Pass Project receive approval from your committee for the following reasons:

- a. NH is a beautiful state and one of whose most important economies is tourism. The 192 mile swath cut through our forests and neighborhoods for the purpose of erecting 135' steel towers would severely detract from the beauty of the state. It would also drive property values down for those unfortunate enough to be in its path.
- b. The energy is not for NH - it is for other states.
- c. If it has to come through, insist that it be buried, perhaps under Interstate 93.
- d. Hydroelectric power is not green - dams cause flooding of forests which then produce methane which then produces mercury in the water. Additionally, much of the land involved in these projects is taken from Native Canadian Tribes in direct opposition to signed treaties.
- e. Allowing this project would curtail development of other more sustainable energy projects such as solar and wind.
- f. Lines already exist that could carry the amount of power proposed by Eversource from Littleton down to Derry. These lines are already built and have the excess capacity needed without further construction except at the Littleton and Derry ends.

I am a hiker and am outraged and sad that this project has gotten as far as it has. Please squelch it now.
