Dear Evaluators,

I live in NJ but visit New Hampshire regularly. This project will severely affect the area environmentally and visually. I am against this project because the scenic and cultural values of New Hampshire's landscape that this 192-mile project would permanently scar, including by clear-cutting 40 new miles of right-of-way in Coos County, and building more than 1100 new steel lattice or monopole towers up to 160 feet high on existing right of way through 132 miles of New Hampshire. This affects my experience enjoying the outdoors in New Hampshire as well as more broadly the impacts on tourism and on visitors coming to New Hampshire to experience its relatively undeveloped and remote character. The applicant of this project has failed to consider alternatives that would avoid or minimize impacts to New Hampshire, such as burying all 192 miles within already disturbed transportation corridors. .I am a member of the AMC, lover of the outdoors, and need to support the 31 out of the 32 communities along the project's proposed path that have voted to oppose the project.
