Dear Site Evaluation Committee,

I urge you not to approve the Northern Pass project. This is not a good project for New Hampshire. Not one bit. You have been told why by intelligent and articulate people who have the interests of the state and its people, view sheds and economy, as well as sound forest management and land management at heart.

I also urge you to require burial of Northern Pass transmission lines in the event you approve the Northern Pass project. All the money Northern Pass has spent so far could have gone to burial of the lines. What a waste.

Every time I read about what is planned for Concord regarding the towers, the towers grow taller for Concord. What was once believed to be 135 feet has now escalated to 165 feet tall. That is 15 feet taller than the Capitol building! That is outrageous. Who are these people who are so presumptuous as to try to force that size tower down our throats? Have they no decency? Towers like that are a visual excrescence. They cannot be allowed. Concord already looks like a third world country with all its above ground wires and poles.
