New Hampshire offers an excellent alternative - follow the I-93 corridor and bury the lines. Why take small but significant portions of land from many people by purchase or by eminent domain, when a sensible alternative exists?

Additionally, the hydro power intended for transmission is itself very destructive. Thousands of acres of boreal forest will be destroyed, the land and livelihood of at least one of Canada's first nations will vanish.
