To whom it may concern,

I currently live in McKenna's Purchase and I am going to assume the committee knows the impact of this project on this area. I have been following this NP project since its inception . I am very opposed to this project not just for my area but for the entire state of NH

Reasons:

1. My property values will go down by 30 % if NP is allowed to be built in back of McKenna's Purchase . Thirty percent decrease and multiply it by 148 units that is a large chunk of change (about 740,000) . The loss of this property tax at McKenna's Purchase may force other property taxes to increase substantially.
2. The NP 's path will be placed just behind James Circle(the area where I live) . I can't imagine what these towers will look like ! Also, we do not know the health risks of this towers very closely placed to our living areas.
3. Concord is more visually impacted (this height of the towers)than any other city or town.
4. The tourism will suffer greatly if NP is allowed to ruin the White Mts with its high towers .
- 5.The NP will not benefit the state of NH (other than workers employed)- all the electricity is going to Ma and CT . I am not willing to support a project that is going to put ugly towers thru the beauty of NH.
