To whom it may concern,

I currently live in Mckenna's Purchase and I am going to assume the committee knows the impact of this project on this area. I have been following this NP project since its inception. I am very opposed to this project not just for my area but for the entire state of NH Reasons:

- 1. My property values will go down by 30 % if NP is allowed to be built in back of McKenna's Purchase. Thirty percent decrease and multiply it by 148 units that is a large chunk of change (about 740,000). The loss of this property tax at Mckenna's Purchase may force other property taxes to increase substantially.
- 2. The NP 's path will be placed just behind James Circle(the area where I live) . I can't imagine what these towers will look like! Also, we do not know the health risks of this towers very closely placed to our living areas.
