Please share my thoughts with the Site Evaluation Committee for Northern Pass.

Members of the Site Evaluation Committee:

I write to express my support of the City of Concord's position to bury the proposed Northern Pass/Hydro-Quebec power line through our city.

During 2015, the City held a number of community forums to discuss this project and the potential impacts to our community. A committee of representatives and citizens gave a collective recommendation that the impacts of this project would be adverse and therefore recommended our city officials take the position to bury the Northern Pass line.

In response this recommendation, the City Council rightly accepted this recommendation and further directed our City Solicitor's Office to act as an intervenor against Northern Pass with an emphasis on the need to bury the lines through Concord. We are resolute that this is the best course for Northern Pass to traverse through our Capital City.

I implore you to support the city's position, as favorably as the North Country was supported with the decision to bury 60-miles of this line. Our community will be no less impacted simply because we are in Central New Hampshire versus the North. Every community in our state relies heavily on tax base expansion that comes from economic development and capturing of tourism dollars. We take seriously every project that has the potential to reduce, limit or hinder our efforts. Northern Pass does just that in some very environmentally sensitive areas of our city, some highly populated areas of our city, and commercial areas of our city. We are being targeted at all of our assets.

Please reject Northern Pass' request for overhead lines and hear our city' plea for burying of the power line through Concord.
