Eversource and Hydro Quebec have both said they aren't paying for the project which raises the question whether either of the companies have the financial capability to build and operate this \$1.6 billion project. The transmission towers and lines are going to have a horrible effect on the landscape, historic sites, and the environment.

I hope the committee will reject this project's certificate to prevent it from harming our state.

The Town of Chesterfield voted at its last town meeting to resist any seizure of lands by eminent domain for projects like Northern Pass that despoil our rural landscape of its beauty, create environmental risks, and threaten our tourism economy.
