As a resident of New Hampshire I hope the SEC will reject Northern Pass's certificate.

Eversource and Hydro Quebec have both said they aren't paying for the project which raises the question whether either of the companies have the financial capability to build and operate this \$1.6 billion project. The transmission towers and lines are going to have a horrible effect on the landscape, historic sites, and the environment in New Hampshire. The transmission line also will not serve our state, as it merely passes through New Hampshire.

I don't see any pluses for New Hampshire's population...we need support for renewable energy sources, and I do not consider the destruction of Canadian human and wildlife habitat renewable...and NH is not getting this electricity, despite all the pretending that is going on! We should be using off-shore wind, as the states south of us are working on, plus supporting the fastest growing sector, solar.
