Dear Mr. Honigberg and SEC members:

I am writing to you about your plans to limit cross examinations of witnesses in the Northern Pass (NP) application. The Chairman's decision to limit cross examination is unreasonable and violates due process.

These restrictions were not imposed on the parties intervening in a friendly manner on behalf of NP. The chair has some discretion on how the SEC manages proceedings, but he can not apply different rules to different parties.

Second requiring questions be submitted before given testimony requires lawyers to have premonitory capabilities on said testimony. This is unreasonable both for allowing opposing lawyers to know your questions before hand and for requiring them to be able to read the future. You can not limit cross examination because the number of opposing entities is too large.

Please change this policy or face further law suits from the opposing parties.
