As a resident of New Hampshire, I hope the SEC will reject Northern Pass's certificate.

Eversource and Hydro Quebec have both said they aren't paying for the project, which raises the question whether either of the companies have the financial capability to build and operate this \$1.6 billion project. The transmission towers and lines are going to have a horrible effect on the landscape, historic sites, and the environment in New Hampshire. Large swaths of what is currently wilderness will have to be kept open for access to the transmission equipment for upgrades and repairs. The electricity carried by these transmission lines will not serve our state: it will be passed on to states south of New Hampshire. As I see it, there is absolutely no benefit to my state and lots of detriment.

I hope the committee will reject this project's certificate to prevent it from harming our state.
