As a resident of New Hampshire I hope the SEC will reject Northern Pass's certificate.

This project offers no tangible long term benefit to our state, but many tangible harms. Jobs created? Only for construction of the Northern Pass. Once construction is completed, most of those jobs go away. Benefit to rate payers? Virtually none. The goal of this project is to transmit power to the more populous regions to our south.

Meanwhile , Eversource and Hydro Quebec, want to install massive electrical towers in some of the most beautiful areas of our state. Tourism in these areas is a major driver of the local economy. Who wants to come to New Hampshire to look at hideous transmission lines.
