Dear Pamela Monroe,

As a resident of New Hampshire I hope the SEC will reject Northern Pass's certificate.

Eversource and Hydro Quebec have both said they aren't paying for the project which raises the question whether either of the companies have the financial capability to build and operate this \$1.6 billion project. The transmission towers and lines are going to have a horrible effect on the landscape, historic sites, and the environment in New Hampshire. The transmission line also will not serve our state, as it merely passes through New Hampshire.

I hope the committee will reject this project's certificate to prevent it from harming our state. I think that there are better options to consider before using a new power line coming through this state. For example, I turned our house to solar via Solar City 2 years ago. We generate 10,000 kilowatts of power a year via renewables. Why can't this state give the OK to use Solar City for Commercial use? I have a building in Salem NH that is perfect for solar and the utility companies in NH won't allow it. This is very backward thinking and we need to change and I am rejecting Northern Pass because there is no good reason for it.,
