I strongly support the statement issued on August 14, 2017 by the Concord City Council. While not a resident of Concord, Concord is my city, I live in Canterbury, where Northern Pass is planned as well. I have opposed this project since the beginning for two main reasons. First, destruction to the environment, starting with the lands of indigenous Canadian people, then all along the route, due to disruption from construction, as well as invasion of natural views throughout New Hampshire; second, our energy future needs to focus on wind, solar, and geothermal renewable sources of energy. While hydro power might be considered "renewable", this project has been extremely disruptive to lands which are certainly not renewable. It is a private, for profit venture which is not in the public interest. Please do not approve this application.
