Dear Pamela Monroe,

The Northern Pass will cause irreparable damage to NH. The list of major harm is disturbing:

- Negative Impact on Property Values
- Permanent Scars to the Landscape
- Significant Disruption to Businesses and Potential Job Losses as a Result
- Damage to Tourism
- Traffic Issues
- Immediate Negative Environmental Impact
- More Ongoing Greenhouse Gases Compared to Other Proposals

Eversource has not been truthful in their submissions to the Massachusetts RFP. For one, not submitting any of the required objections to their proposal when in fact there have been numerous objections for the past seven years.

There are other options that provide more power to those states who are demanding it, our power demand in NH has decreased. Granite State Power Link would deliver 1,200 megawatts of modern wind power from Canada to New England. Northern Pass would deliver 1,000 megawatts. More power at less cost, using an existing network of towers adding only 6 miles of new corridor in the northern NH and about 10 in the south. Compare that to 192 miles of damage and destruction that Eversource and the Northern Pass is offering.

It's obvious that the Northern Pass is not the best option for New Hampshire. Please reject the Northern Pass.
