Have you ever heard of a tower being REMOVED? Me neither. Northern Pass proposes something that will outlive our children's children's children -- even though, in a hundred years, there is NO WAY IN HELL we'll still be reliant on this ancient technology.

The Northern Pass project will be absolutely horrible for local wildlife and habitat, already at grave risk from development.
