Dear Commissioners:

There have been several town meetings in which the citizens of Plymouth have stated and voted against Northern Pass. Several years ago we voted overwhelmingly to pass a Rights Based Ordinance for Sustainable Energy. We voted last year for an ordinance that stated the town is opposed to Northern Pass. And two years ago, the town met at the high school to tell the Select Board that Plymouth stands united against Northern Pass and we don't want the town to negotiate with Northern Pass.

Despite all that, the Plymouth Village Water and Sewer Department agreed to negotiate and sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Northern Pass. It is hard to believe that your department had no idea the level of opposition there is to this project by the community. If approved, it will cause enormous damage to our business community by digging up Main Street for long periods of time and rerouting traffic through neighborhoods away from the business district. The construction will not only affect businesses along Main Street, Plymouth State University and tourism, but could seriously affect the safety and welfare of the town by slowing down emergency vehicles.

We are very disappointed in your refusal to obey the wishes and directives of the community by negotiating with Northern Pass. We ask that you rescind this agreement and abide by the sentiment of the voters of Plymouth.
