For Public Comment

I am Michael Bruno and I am a lifelong NH resident. I have made Bethlehem NH my home for the past 11 years. It was recently brought to my attention that the Site Evaluation Committee is accepting letters for Public Comment to be added to the Northern Pass file. I would like to add to the record that as a NH citizen and particularly a resident of a community directly affected by the Northern Pass project that I am vehemently opposed to this project.

New Hampshire is being treated as the conduit with no benefit of this project. Sub station 5 is currently located directly on US Route 302 and will be an ugly structure as tourists enter our community. Secondly, with a recently approved hotel on an abutters property, this project may be in jeopardy of being constructed if the NP project is not modified as was agreed with NP and the property owner. I have attended NP sessions and find it disheartening that the NP applicants cannot be candid and admit that their design has major flaws affecting private property owners with no adequate answers. I believe their lack of transparency is their effort to get it approved first, and then consider modifications. This is bad business. Lastly, I am not confident that either the SEC, nor the applicant is sincerely listening to the citizens of the affected communities.
