People who live in NH and those who visit do so for the quality of life and the environment. The pristine beauty of the state, in particular the Great North Woods, the White Mountains and the River valleys, draw millions of tourists. All four seasons. This high voltage transmission line will destroy this natural environment. Property values will drop. Businesses dependent on tourism, one of the state's major revenue sources, will suffer from lost business as will the state, putting more revenue burden on property owners.

Current power lines and wind farms do not have the same impact as this project, due to the monstrous size of the towers being proposed.
