Dear Pamela Monroe,

Please reject the Northern Pass proposal. It makes no sense for New Hampshire economically, or environmentally: There is nothing in it for us. and it will do us harm.

- 1, Virtually all the energy produced will go to consumers in Southern New England, if those states do not choose one of the two alternatives.
2. The construction will scar the New Hampshire landscape with serious negative impacts on tourism and recreation based businesses.
3. The finished product would have a permanent negative impact on tourism and real estate values along the entire corridor.
4. Any jobs created (except for a very few) will be temporary, and go largely to out of state skilled workers.

More NH people would be likely to get work if all the Canadian proposals were rejected and the power companies had to construct local wind, and solar facilities to meet their "environmentally sound" energy production requirements.

5. The disruption from construction would have a serious negative impact on wildlife, be a corridor for invasive plants and insects with possible permanent disruption of our environment and outdoor industries and recreation .
6. Any environmental gains here will be offset by the damage in Canada from drowning forests that absorb CO2.

Pleas "just say no" to Northern Pass.
