I live in Hollis, NH, and have a strong interest in the NED pipeline project currently before the SEC. I urge the committee to file a motion to intervene with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. But should the SEC miss the January 15 deadline, you will have no rights over this matter with FERC.

I would consider it an abdication of the SEC's responsibilities for the SEC not to file as an intervenor.
