The current Rule 300 standards provide a framework for regulation of typical projects such as wind farms, but they fall vastly short when considering a project of the scope, magnitude and potential impacts of high pressure gas pipelines. No single category of infrastructure poses the possible risks to health, safety, water, air quality, wildlife, environment, property, agriculture and tourism presented by gas pipelines.

The SEC bears the heavy burden of responsibility for regulating the shape of New Hampshire's energy landscape for future generations. I ask that you permit time for proper consideration and input.
