**REPORT OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On June 14, 2018, a prehearing conference was held in the above referenced docket.

Commissioner Michael Giaimo served as the Presiding Officer. This memorandum serves as a Report of the Prehearing Conference pursuant to RSA 541-A:31, V(d). Notice of the prehearing conference was issued on May 30, 2018.

Participants

New Hampshire Transmission, LLC (NHT) appeared through its attorney Douglas Patch, Esq. Counsel for the Public, Gordon Landrigan, Esq., appeared. Pamela Monroe, Administrator and Michael Iacopino, Counsel to the Site Evaluation Committee were both present.

General Discussion

The participants were advised of the scope and nature of a prehearing conference. No motions to intervene have been filed in this docket. NHT and Counsel for the Public agreed that discovery would be informal and that there is no need to issue a discovery schedule.

Commissioner Giaimo advised the parties that a site visit would be scheduled. *See* Site 202.13 (a). The Administrator was asked to determine an appropriate date and agenda for the site visit.

After consideration of the availability of the Subcommittee and the parties, the following procedural schedule is adopted:

Site Visit: July 12, 2018 at 2 p.m. An Order and Notice will be issued.

Final Public Hearing: July 13, 2018 at 9 a.m. at the offices of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, N.H. 03301.

The Final Public Hearing shall be conducted as an adjudicative proceeding and may include deliberations on the merits of the Petition.
