RE: Technical Session Data Requests

On April 8, 2020, a remote technical session was held via Cisco Webex in the above referenced docket. Procedures for the remote technical session were provided in advance to the parties and the members of the public that submitted a request to participate. The technical session is a form of discovery that enables the parties to inquire of the Applicant's witnesses as to their expertise, opinions, and prefiled testimony. At the conclusion of the technical session, the following data requests from Counsel for the Public to the Applicant remain outstanding:

- 1. Provide all field notes, dates of site visits, and a list of personnel and their qualifications, including Tracy Sudhalter, and anyone else that conducted the field surveys for the Forest Composition Report and/or for the Habitat Assessment.
- 2. Provide all plan pages showing changes to the temporary access road and the laydown areas located to the south of the Project site. (This may have been resolved by reference to Appendix E to the AOT Application and Appendix. 8-b of the Application.)
- 3. Provide the environmental assessment and the limits of the study area that was conducted for the main access road off of Fullam Hill Road.
- 4. Provide documentation supporting the claim that NHNHB indicated that no rare species surveys are required.

- 5. Provide the raw data from all field notes taken during the wetland delineations, stream assessment data, and site assessments, including Fulcrum Data. Provide all forms, photos, and assessments of any kind developed by all consultants that worked on the Project.
- 6. Provide all the reasons and supporting data that exists that support changes in the delineation of wetlands.
- 7. Provide coordinates of the data plots of wetlands and uplands that were surveyed, including wetland EBL 2019-07.
- 8. Provide any written correspondence between Craig Rennie of NHDES and the Applicant, regarding potential wetlands impacts as referenced in the November 26, 2019, letter from the Applicant to the Administrator.
- 9. Provide a map of the areas within the project area that were not mapped/surveyed/delineated. (This may have been resolved.)
- 10. Provide all GIS data, to the extent that it can be provided, for the properties outside of the parcel/project area.

Responses to the above data requests shall be provided to Counsel for the Public no later than April 20, 2020. Copies shall **not** be provided to the Committee. To the extent that the Applicant objects to providing the above referenced material, Counsel for the Public may file a Motion to Compel with the Committee.

Please note that the technical session for all of the Applicant's witnesses was completed on April 8; therefore, the technical session scheduled on April 9, is cancelled.
