I would like to submit to the SEC my February 21, 2020 email that you will find below addressed to NH F&G's Nongame & Endangered Wildlife Program, along with its three attachments, as comment on the Chinook Solar Project – Docket No. 2019-02, as it provides more detail to the comments I spoke at the SEC's February 20 hearing.

At the SEC hearing on February 20, I spoke a comment that records show logging occurring in 2018 and 2019 and raised the question as to whether the logging may fall under the definition of "commencement of construction" as defined in RSA 162-H,III. Under 162:5,I construction may not begin until there is a certificate. I mentioned the wetlands impacts on one of the lots that are revealed in a DES Wetlands Forestry Notification. I also mentioned F&G's concern about the logging being conducted outside of winter, that is, in spring, summer and fall when bats are inhabiting the forests. The Notices of Intent to Cut and associated reports are attached.

RE: PROBLEM: Bad news for Little Brown Bats at Chinook Solar site – logging during spring, summer & fall in 2018/2019 time period.

Dear Ms. Houghton, Ms. Tuttle, Ms. Doperalski, and Ms. Henderson:

Way back in December 2017 F&G provided the important guidance to the Chinook Solar people to protect bats, including the endangered Little Brown Bat, to log in winter between the dates of November 1 and March 31. The Chinook Solar representatives agreed in writing to winter logging.

Unfortunately, records in the files of the Town of Fitzwilliam provide the following information about a great deal of actual or potential logging (total amount could be over 150 acres) that has occurred in 2018 and 2019 or was planned to occur in 2019 or 2020 -- outside of winter. Copies of the records are attached for your review.

LOT #12-50 (two records)

2018 Notice of Intent to Cut on Lot #12-50 on Fullam Hill Road (owned by Dave Rich)

Acreage of the lot --- 128 acres

Acreage of the cut --- 50 acres [expected]

Anticipated start date - May 1, 2018

2018 Report of Wood or Timber Cut for the cut on Lot #12-50

Exact acreage of the cut --- 87 acres

The cutting was complete as of August 3, 2018

Summary: Lot #12-50 had 87 acres cut between May 1, 2018 and August 3, 2018.

Summary: Lot #12-3 was anticipating having another 10 acres cut in September of 2019, in addition to the 25 or so cut in 2018.

LOT #12-29 (1 record plus the Wetlands Impact Map)

2019 Notice of Intent to Cut on Lot #12-29 (310 Rte 199E) (owned by John Fedier, Jr.)

Acreage of the lot --- 75 acres

Acreage of the cut --- 70 acres

Anticipated start date --- June 10, 2019

Summary: Lot #12-29 was anticipating cutting 70 acres in summer of 2019. In addition, Lot #12-29 has a Forestry Notification dated June 13, 2019 for which they describe wetlands impacts. Anecdotally, I heard from a source in Fitzwilliam that there was logging under wet conditions, so I wonder if the source may have been referring to Lot #12-29's work under the Forestry Notification.

The Google Earth image below is dated September 2019 and shows evidence of a recent large clear cut on the site of Chinook Solar.



Last night (February 20, 2020) at the Site Evaluation Committee's (SEC) meeting in Fitzwilliam, the Chinook Solar representative from NextEra told the SEC that his company was not in control of what the landowners are doing, but said that NextEra had sent a letter to the landowners about stopping the logging. No other details were provided.

My comments are these: Chinook Solar agreed since 2017 to conduct logging only in winter, but has since stood by as up to three landowners logged or plan to log their land outside of winter in 2018 and 2019 and beyond, with unknown harm to the bats, including the endangered Little Brown Bat.

Chinook Solar also has stated that there would be no wetlands impacts by the project; however, the Forestry Notification of Lot #12-29 reveals that there are wetlands impacts. I was informed by DES' Ryan Duquette that Chinook Solar will be required to file for a regular wetlands permit when the use changes from forestry to development of solar.

Additionally, NHB has identified both the Blanding's and Wood turtles who appear to not have been excluded from the dangerous logging areas, as can be done by use of exclusionary silt fencing, following eviction of the turtles.

Please investigate the harm that may have been caused to T&E bats (there's a "pre" study to compare against) and turtles and take necessary action to enforce protections for T&E under RSA 212-A. As for review of the AoT application from the perspective of no adverse impact to T&E or even not jeopardizing the species of bat, I think there is a lot to consider already as very negative against approval.

Little brown bats were detected at nearly all of the acoustic monitoring stations. My recommendation would be a confirm that tree removal will be in the winter (November 1-March 31) and where possible maintain forested contact that connect suitable foraging habitat (wetlands/waterbodies). This may overlap with efforts to provide connect the vernal pools as woodland seasonal pools are important foraging and water sources for the little brown bat.

Hi Carol.

Thank you for your time discussing the Chinook Solar project last Tuesday, 8/27/2019. To help refresh your memory, the project is a proposed 30 megawatt solar electric generation project is located in Fitzwilliam, NH and it will be the subject of an application to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee. Below is a summary of the key wildlife protection strategies and best management practices the Chinook Solar Project will implement based on correspondence and recommendations from meetings with the NHF&G in 2017 and 2018. We kindly request your review of, and concurrence with, the wildlife protection measures identified herein.

Fencing:

- The Project was designed to account for anticipated wildlife corridors through the Project area. Fencing for the solar panel arrays will be installed around discrete sections of the Project such that corridors for larger wildlife species will remain available.
- Fencing around the solar panel arrays will be a 7-foot tall chain link fence installed with an approximate 6-inch gap between the ground and the fence to allow smaller wildlife species to pass beneath the fence.
- The Project substation, about 2 acres in size, will be surrounded by a 7-foot tall chain link fence with no gap between the ground and the fence with an additional foot of barbed wire along the top of the fence for security purposes.


Protection for Bats:

- The Project design maintains forested corridors that connect potential foraging habitats (wetlands/waterbodies) for bats.
- Tree clearing for the Project will occur between November 1 and March 31 to avoid
 potential impacts to roosting bats during the summer season when they are active
 throughout the landscape.

Protection for Turtles:

- To help minimize the potential of turtles entering the Project area during construction, a
 perimeter silt fence will be installed around the entirety of the construction area as an
 exclusion barrier. The perimeter silt fence will be installed sometime following turtle
 hibernation and before emergence in the spring.
- Small ramps constructed of erosion control mix will be installed intermittently along the
 interior of the perimeter silt fence so that in the event that a turtle enters the construction
 area, it will be able to exit the exclusion area using one of the ramps.
- An environmental monitor (qualified biologist) will inspect the perimeter of the
 construction area prior to the start of construction each day to search for any turtles that
 may have entered the exclusion area and to inspect the condition of the perimeter silt
 fence. Any turtle found within the silt fence will be relocated outside of the construction
 area.
- Stormwater basins will be designed with sloped sides to provide for egress of turtles.
- · Environmental training will be provided to all individuals working at the Project during
