**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER AND NOTICE OF
ADJUDICATIVE HEARING**

On May 3, 2021, Tusk Wind Holdings III, LLC (Tusk), BAIF Granite Holdings, LLC and Granite Reliable Power, LLC (collectively Brookfield) and Freshet Wind Energy LLC (Freshet) filed a Petition to Transfer Membership Interests in BAIF Granite Holdings LLC and Granite Reliable Power LLC to Tusk Wind Holdings III, LLC (Petition). The Petition pertains to the Certificate of Site and Facility awarded to Granite Reliable Power, LLC on July 15, 2009, in Docket 2008-04.

On July 6, 2021, the Subcommittee issued a Procedural Order and Notice of Adjudicative Hearing.

This supplemental notice updates the previous notice due to the expiration of the declared State of Emergency on June 11, 2021. With the expiration of the State of Emergency, the Subcommittee must comply with all requirements of RSA chapter 91-A, including the requirement that a quorum of a public body must be physically present at the location specified as the location of the public meeting in the meeting notice. The Subcommittee is aware that not all parties, have returned to full in-person work environments. Therefore, for the foreseeable future, the Subcommittee intends to provide a hybrid approach to hearings to accommodate those who are remote and those who are physically present. A quorum of the Subcommittee will be physically present within a hearing room for all Subcommittee hearings.

In order to facilitate the hybrid approach, all parties participating in the hearing room will continue to participate on the web-enabled platform. Parties and the public may continue to participate in hearings remotely using the web-enabled platform.

Each party in this proceeding has the right to have an attorney represent the party at the party's expense.


Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby:

ORDERED, that the Subcommittee will hold a hearing in this matter at the office of the Public Utilities Commission at 21 S. Fruit St., Suite 10, Concord, New Hampshire, on **July 26, 2021, at 9:00 a.m.** The Subcommittee Members will be present in the hearing room and will use a web-enabled platform to conduct the hearing. FURTHER ORDERED, that this Supplemental Order and Notice shall be published on the Committee's website and posted at the offices of the Department of Environmental Services and the Public Utilities Commission no later than one business day after the date of issue.
