Dear Ms. Martin: 22 September 2021

SEC Organizational Rule 301.18:i states that "Validation of noise complaints ..... shall be conducted under the same meteorological conditions as occurred at the time of the alleged exceedance that is the subject of the complaint". There have been many public complaints over many months, only one of which was ever even discussed by your committee, and that complaint was "investigated" under totally different meteorological conditions as occurred at the time of the complaint.

Since that time many more complaints have been made, not one of which has been investigated, and NO complaint has ever received even a suggestion that AWE knows, or will reveal the meteorological conditions that occurred at their time, including particularly the meteorological conditions on the AWE site. Without these data, no outside party can do a thorough professional check of any sound levels to compare with those on the night of the complaint.

I request that your upcoming meeting of the 23<sup>rd</sup> speak to this issue, including allowing me to ask AWE about the meteorological conditions at the times of those complaints, the availability of the site meteorological data, and any comparisons already performed by AWE.
