1) I'm interested in receiving the AWE wind raw data. Lisa Linowes has that response too and I'm sure she will be happy for me to take the "first crack" at it and pass it along with my notes and whatever I find in the data. My career has been in operating system development and understand the technical discussions about sound data. (And I understand the Nyquist frequency, probably better than Dr. Fred Ward.)
